

## LIFE UNDER THE SUN

Text: Eccl. 1:13

INTRO: The book of Ecclesiastes is one of the most interesting books in the Bible. The writer is Solomon. Though outside this book, we have no information on Solomon as a preacher, he is the only one who could be described in such verses as 1:1, 12, 16.

This book relates Solomon's search for meaning in life. It sums all the wise man had learned.

SPECIAL NOTES: The word "vanity" is used repeatedly to mean fleeting or temporary. It does not have its common meaning of uselessness, 11:10.

This book gives very little attention to the after-life. It deals with facts & problems concerning the earth-life, life under the sun.
